



# **Archaeology Presentation**



At the August Circle Meeting, brothers and our visitors were treated to a presentation by Ray Kennedy of Cotswold Archaeology. He spoke about the planning process and that prior to any development, an archaeological assessment of the area is made. This includes what is termed a desk-based analysis, and may include a 'watching brief' at the site while it is being developed. There may also be an archaeological excavation; he illustrated this by describing a development at Andover where several skeletons were unearthed. The site was clearly an execution site dating to the Saxon period, since many of the skeletons had their skulls detached. Questions following the presentation were a testament to the interest in the subject.
